

## **French 4-2 Learning Outcomes**

Students should be able to:

- **Speak about planning a trip abroad including making travel arrangements. (Future tense) Go through customs and get around at a train station and the airport.**
- **Check into a hotel and ask for services.**
- **Compare people, things and places. (Comparative and Superlative)**
- **Ask about objects (Which? Which one?) and answer distinguishing one object from another (This one, that one, these, those).**
- **Describe physical symptoms, explain what is wrong, give information about their medical history, and understand a doctor's prescription.**
- **Express how they and others feel about certain facts or events. (Subjunctive after expressions of emotion)**
- **Express fear, doubt or disbelief. (Expressions of doubt and uncertainty)**
- **Express feelings or attitudes about past actions and events. (Past subjunctive)**
- **Narrating past actions in sequence. (Pluperfect)**
- **Hypothesize about what one would do under certain circumstances. (Conditional and its uses)**
- **Be familiar with some events in 20<sup>th</sup> century France. Understand Modern France as an ethnic and multi-cultural society.**

- **Read an entire story, answer questions orally and in writing.**
- **Speak with an accent that is not so marked by students' native language that it interferes with comprehension**
