

The Rosemary Fichera Kennedy Nadolski Award

In 2003, The Lincoln Scholarship Committee together with Tom, Tommy, and Adam Nadolski established **The Rosemary Fichera Kennedy Nadolski Award**. Rosemary's family established this annual award in her memory. Rosemary Nadolski embodied a singular generosity of spirit and throughout her life, lent her hand and her heart to all whose paths she crossed. Rosemary was a long time resident of Lincoln who died unexpectedly in October 2002. The award is administered by the Lincoln Scholarship Committee.

This award is given each year to a high school senior from Lincoln who consistently strives to help others within our community, without regard for reciprocation or even acknowledgment. This student strongly embodies the special qualities that Rosemary represented. Friends and family remember Rosemary as being a kind, generous, giving and unselfish person who was a hard worker and non-stop champion of children, both her own and others. They particularly remember her gentle caring and the extra effort she exerted to help others when they were having troubles -- not because of wanting any personal recognition, but just because she felt it was the "right thing to do."

Each year the recipient is selected from a pool of those seniors who are nominated for the award. Candidates may be nominated by fellow students, school faculty or administration, and/or townspeople of Lincoln. Nominating forms and information on deadlines will be available in the early Spring of each year.
