Goals

- 1) School Committee (LSSC) Communications
 - a) LSSC-to-Community: Seasonal updates (Fall, Winter, Spring, and Summer) called 'LS Matters' provided to LS community, as well as to local Lincoln and Sudbury news outlets.
 - b) Community-to-LSSC: Monthly daytime and evening Listening Sessions/Office Hours in Lincoln, Sudbury and Boston during the year.
- 2) School Committee (LSSC) Initiatives
 - a) School Start Time: Potential implementation scenarios developed using collaborative approach to include costs/benefits/tradeoffs analyses.
 - b) School Safety: Community Forum convened to include L-S Safety Council updates regarding student physical and social-emotional safety.
 - c) Strategic Planning: Ongoing school survey data integrated into inclusive and collaborative district priority-setting and performance planning processes.
